

Moon letter mnemonics

- ^ A** – Up the mountain, down the mountain. Climbing up the mountains called the Alps. It's the letter . . .
- ∩ B** – Down, around and up. Like a fishhook catching a bass. It's the letter . . .
- ∪ C** – It's curvy at the top and curvy at the bottom like the whiskers of a cat. It's the letter . . .
- ∩ D** – This letter directs the ducks, out, down and in. It curves out right and curves around, it's directing. It's the letter . . .
- ⌊ E** – Up and to the right, this letter stands up straight and has extra wide shoulders like an elephant. It's the letter . . .

- ∩ G** – It goes up, is curved around and down like a walking stick that goes gallump. It's the letter . . .
- H** – This person's head is on the side and they're wearing a hat. It's the letter . . .
- | I** – It's long and thin like a pen with ink. It's the letter . . .
- J J** – The left is low, it swings right up high, like a jumping jack-in-the-box. It's the letter . . .
- < K** – Its left is closed, but the right is open wide like the beak of a kookaburra. Koo [oo as in cook] koo, ka ka, ka. It's the letter . . .
- L L** – This letter has a line on the left, then down below it's long and low. It's the letter . . .
- ⌋ M** – It's straight along the top and bends in the top right corner to stand up tall like mummy. It's the letter . . .
- N N** – It's twisting and turning; up, diagonally down, up. Like nice, new noodles. It's the letter . . .

- O – It's round and round like an orange. It's the letter . . .
- ⌞ P – This letter is pointing to the left, pecking like the beak on a parrot.

- ⌵ Q – It's flat on the bottom with a bow on the top. Like a quiet slipper of the queen.

- ↘ R – This letter rushes, down the ramp, running to the right.

- ↗ S – This letter strides, a right steep step up the steep slope.
